NOTICE PURSUANT TO THE UTILITY ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT OF AN APPLICATION TO A FEDERAL AGENCY BY GRIDLIANCE WEST LLC TO CONSTRUCT THE TROUT CANYON TO PAHRUMP TRANSMISSION LINE UPGRADE PROJECT

I. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to the Nevada Utility Environmental Protection Act ("UEPA"), Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") Sections 704.820 to 704.900 and Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"), Sections 703.415 to 703.427 of GridLiance West LLC ("GridLiance West") hereby files a Notice with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (the "Commission") that GridLiance West is filing, contemporaneous with this Notice, an application with a federal agency to allow it to construct the Trout Canyon to Pahrump Transmission Line Upgrade Project which involves an upgrade of the approximately 14.1-mile-long existing overhead single-circuit 230 kilovolt ("kV") transmission line system and two substations and the construction of ancillary facilities (the "Project").

The Project falls within the definition of a "utility facility" pursuant to NRS 704.860.2 (a) as an electric transmission lines and transmission substations that are designed to operate at 200 kilovolts or more. Because the Project is located on federal land administered by the Bureau of

Land Management ("BLM"), an environmental analysis of the Project pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA"), 42 U.S.C. §4321 must be conducted. Accordingly, this Notice is being filed pursuant to NRS 704.870(2)(a) and NAC 703.421. No later than 30 days after the issuance of the final federal environmental document, GridLiance West will file a UEPA Application with the Commission pursuant to NRS 704.870(2)(b) that contains the federal environmental document. Upon submission of the Application and supporting documents, GridLiance West will seek one or more Permits to Construct the Project from the Commission.

II. INFORMATION REQUIRED

1. The name, address and telephone number of the person who is filing the application with the appropriate federal agency. (NAC 703.421.1)

2. The date on which the application was filed with the appropriate federal agency. (NAC 703.421.2)

The SF 299 for the Project is being filed with the BLM contemporaneously with this Notice on July 29, 2022.

3. A general description of the location of the proposed utility facility. (NAC 703.421.3)

The Project extends from the Trout Canyon Substation in Clark County, northward through Nye County, terminating at the Pahrump Substation.

4. A general description of the proposed utility facility. (NAC 703.421.4)

GridLiance West is upgrading a portion of its existing single-circuit 230-kV overhead transmission line system between the Trout Canyon Substation and the Pahrump Substation and upgrades or expansions of two associated substations (Gamebird Substation and Pahrump Substation).

The upgraded transmission line will generally be adjacent to the existing single-circuit 230-

kV transmission line alignment, except for the Gamebird Substation to Pahrump Substation segment, where the upgraded transmission line will be routed in a different location to minimize impacts on private property that would occur with an upgrade directly adjacent to the existing line.

The existing overhead transmission system is approximately 14.1 miles long and comprised of two segments of single-circuit 230-kV transmission line. Portions of the single-circuit transmission line (the Gamebird Substation to Pahrump Substation segment) are hung on poles and in rights of way shared with 138-kV infrastructure owned and operated by Valley Electric Association. The approximately 14.1 miles of existing 230-kV transmission line will be decommissioned following construction of the upgraded transmission line.

5. Proof that a copy of the notice has been submitted to the Nevada State Clearinghouse within the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources. (NAC 703.421.5)

A copy of this Notice has been submitted to the Regulatory Operations Staff of the Commission, the Nevada Attorney General's Bureau of Consumer Protection, Nevada State Clearinghouse, the Nevada Department of Conservation and Natural Resources - Division of Environmental Protection, the Clark and Nye Counties Clerk and others. *See* Certificate of Service attached to this Notice as Exhibit A.

6. Draft Notice. (NAC 703.1620)

A copy of the draft notice pursuant to NAC 703.162 is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

7. Proof of Compliance with the Nevada Department of Wildlife Energy Cost Recovery Fund Program. (NRS 701.600-640)

Pursuant to NRS 701.610, a person who files an application with the Federal Government for a lease or easement for a right-of-way for an energy development project or an application with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada or any county in this State relating to the construction of an energy development project shall, concurrently with the filing of the application, file a notice of the energy development project with the Nevada Department of Wildlife ("NDOW"). The NDOW Application for Energy Projects Fund for the Recovery of Costs for the Project was filed on July 29, 2022, and a copy is attached hereto as Exhibit C.

III. CONCLUSION

GridLiance West will submit its UEPA Application at the conclusion of the federal environmental review process. At that time, it will request that the Commission issue to it one or more UEPA Permits to Construct the Project pursuant to NRS 704.870(2)(b) and NAC 703.423.
